Prerequisite(s): Chinese 1150 or Chinese 1151, or permission of the department.

Course description:

This course is intended to build upon language competence and skills developed previously in modern standard Chinese (Mandarin), to enlarge students' vocabulary and to increase their understanding of more complex grammatical structures. Pinyin romanization will be used throughout the course. Reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills will be emphasized. Special emphasis will be given to recognizing and writing Chinese characters and short compositions.

Learning Objectives:

Acquire basic language skills of modern standard Chinese:

- Be able to recognize and write about 800 basic characters;
- Master 50 or so sentence patterns/grammar points and use them in translating sentences and writing short passages;
- Conduct informal dialogue in modern standard Chinese;
- Use at least one Chinese input method to type Chinese.

Methods:

This course adopts a learner-centered teaching approach. Classes are composed of weekly tests (quizzes and dictations) and task-oriented activities. The instructor will lead such activities and provides necessary explanations for important grammar items, sentence structures, and vocabulary. Students are expected to prepare for every class by previewing and reviewing. They must actively participate in the classroom activities.

Textbooks:

Yuehua Liu, et al., *Integrated Chinese* 中文听说读写 Level 1 Part 2, **Third edition**. Boston: Cheng & Tsui Company, 2009. This set consists of a Textbook, a Workbook, and a Character Workbook.

Evaluation:

1. Attendance	10%

- 3. Collected homework is evaluated and marked. Mistakes are expected to be corrected by the student. Common errors will be discussed in class and further questions can be directed towards the teacher.
- 4. All quizzes and dictations are done in class. There are no exceptions and no make-up, but one worst quiz mark/ dictation mark will be dropped at the end of the second term.
- 6. For those with special needs, the two major tests and final exam can be arranged to be completed through Student Accessibility Services.
- 5. There will be one major test each term and a final exam. No make-ups will be given, except in the case of documented medical or compassionate circumstances.
